

In order to ensure and provide an enjoyable and safe experience for all while visiting or using the City of Commerce Public Library premises, the following conduct, behavior and acts are **PROHIBITED**:

1. Illegal behavior including but not limited to: acts of violence, brandishing a weapon, theft, arson, stalking, harassment, smoking, loitering, exhibitionism or voyeurism, offensive touching, obscene acts, sexual conduct, gambling, being under the influence of, using, selling or possessing alcohol or illegal drugs.
2. Engaging in disruptive conduct that disturbs others. Such conduct includes, but is not limited to: talking loudly, making noise, invading other's privacy, leering, lurking, cursing, abusive and/or threatening language or gestures.
3. Destroying, damaging, defacing or misusing Library materials, equipment, furniture or premises.
4. Leaving the Library without checking out library materials on his or her own library card. Patrons who trigger the theft detection system may be required to open bags, backpacks, purses or briefcases for inspection.
5. Failing to comply with a reasonable staff request.
6. Neglecting to provide proper supervision of children. Library Staff is not responsible for the supervision of children.
7. Running, skating, rollerblading, skateboarding, scooter riding and throwing things.
8. Entering non-public areas of the Library without staff permission.
9. Bringing animals other than those approved as guidance/assistance animals, or for the purposes of Library approved events or programs.
10. Petitioning, soliciting, selling merchandise, distributing handbills or flyers, without the express permission of a Library Supervisor.
11. Begging or panhandling.
12. Using cell phones, pagers or other communication devices inside the Library.
13. Using audible devices without headphones or with headphones set at a volume that disturbs others.
14. Consuming food or beverages inside the Library. Food or drink, including water bottles, must be stored inside bags, backpacks, purses or briefcases.
15. Overcrowding in seating areas.
16. Obstructing entrances, exits, aisles and passageways. Scooters must be completely collapsed if brought into the Library.
17. Bringing bicycles inside the Library.
18. Leaving personal belongings unattended. The Library is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items in or on Library premises. Unattended personal items may be discarded.
19. Bringing excessive baggage including sleeping bags, bedrolls, luggage and shopping carts.
20. Sleeping. This does not apply to young children.
21. Entering the library without shirts or shoes.
22. Causing odors, unassociated with health related problems, which bring forth complaints or cause discomfort to others.
23. Engaging in any activity in violation of Federal, State, local or other applicable law, or Library policy.

ENFORCEMENT

Violation of any of the Rules of Conduct may result in exclusion from the Library premises for the remainder of the day. Repeated or severe incidents may result in a more extended loss of privileges. While a violation of these Rules of Conduct may not constitute criminal conduct, criminal charges may be filed, when appropriate, against anyone who disobeys an order. The City may issue suspensions or take any other action which excludes or suspends any Library patron from the Library as a result of their violation of the Rules of Conduct.

Additionally, the City of Commerce Public Library will uphold all state, federal and local laws and ordinances with regard to public behavior. Assistance from the East Los Angeles Sheriffs Department will be requested as needed.
