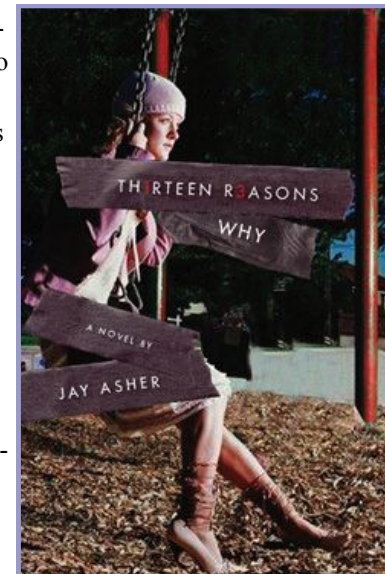
## September Book Selection: Thirteen Reasons Why by Jay Asher

**Thirteen Reasons Why** by Jay Asher - Clay Jensen returns home from school to find a strange package with his name on it lying on his porch. Hannah's voice tells him that there are thirteen reasons why she decided to end her life. Clay is one of them. If he listens, he'll find out why. Clay spends the night crisscrossing his town with Hannah as his guide. He becomes a first-hand witness to Hannah's pain, and learns the truth about himself-a truth he never wanted to face.

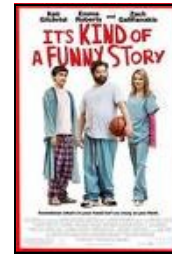
